

RESPIRATORY INFECTION ETIQUETTE

ATTENTION!

VISITORS, please inform a staff member if you have signs or symptoms of any respiratory infection. In addition, please adhere to the following:

Cover:



- Use a tissue or the crook of the elbow during a cough or a sneeze.
- Despite covering during coughs and sneezes, sit at least 3 feet away from other people.
- Dispose of used tissues or wash unclean clothing as soon as possible.

Wash:



Wash all objects and clothing that could have been contaminated with the associated respiratory infection.

Wash hands by performing effective hand hygiene:

- Wash with warm water and soap
- OR use an alcohol based hand sanitizer
- OR use an antiseptic hand wash



Wear:

Wear a mask to minimize the distance that secretions may travel. Wear a mask as much as possible and not just during a cough or sneeze. Dispose of the mask after use.



Alert:

Alert a staff member if you have signs or symptoms of any respiratory infection. Suggest adhering to certain precautions from the Standard Precautions (i.e. Droplet Precautions, Contact Precautions, Airborne Precautions, etc.)
